COMMUNITY TENNIS 101 (Ages 8-18)

Introduction to tennis designed by the USTA. Junior tennis taught in parks and local community centers. All levels of players are welcome to participate in this program.



GRADES 3-5

ACE (*Academic Creative Engagement*) is NJTL-T's out-of-school academic curriculum designed for third to fifth grade students. Lessons are connected to 21st Century Skills, National and Core State Standards and the sport of tennis.

NJTLT MINECRAFT EDUCATION - GRADES 3-12

NJTL of Trenton is utilizing Minecraft Education to design a whole new world. By combining Zoom with Minecraft Ed., students are challenged to complete tasks collaboratively. While immersed in a digital environment, students explore and construct solutions which require strong social connections. They may be asked to build a room, a home, or a school which supports and enriches the lives of the society and fosters a sense of belonging. The tasks are rich and varied and generate a social experience combined with a meaningful interaction. Every task demands problem solving and communication. Students need more than tech skills. Social emotional skills are also used as tools to build solutions and create new opportunities. This game based learning keeps our students engaged while fostering confidence, self-awareness and leadership.



GRADES 4-12

BLOOMBERG CODING PROGRAM

Provided by Bloomberg's Corporate Philanthropy & Engagement department, this on-line coding program is taught by Bloomberg financial tech engineers. For 4th through 12 graders, this virtual program meets weekly via Zoom. Students will have fun learning skills in coding, computer programming, and website design.



GRADES 6-8

THE LAWRENCEVILLE SCHOOL

Lawrentians Educating for Advancement Program "LEAP" is a partnership between NJTL of Trenton and The Lawrenceville School designed for middle school students in our Ashe Program. Students are taught creative writing and public speaking skills. The goal of the program is to enhance student's ability to write essays for private school applications.



GRADES 6-12

ASHE ELITE

NJTL-T's Flagship Program: Student-athletes participate in year-round tennis and educational programs designed for sixth-twelfth graders. Students are expected to complete three requirements: 1) attend tennis training regularly, 2) participate in enrichment programs, 3) complete volunteer/community service hours throughout the school year. Coaches have designed a program that promotes technical, tactical and athletic development. Players have weekly match play while also participating regularly in Junior Team Tennis and tournaments.

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
